Hospice care is not curative in its goals and treatments. Referrals are usually made when a serious condition is believed to be advancing, when medical intervention has reached its maximum benefit, or when the individual or family representative decides to refocus on maintaining comfort and symptom management at home rather than in the hospital. Early response to these circumstances best allows meaningful support to patients and their families.

We don't seek to prolong life beyond its natural course, nor does our involvement hasten death in any way. Prognosis is reviewed frequently, and hospice discontinues if the condition has stabilized or if a decision is made to pursue curative treatment. Hospice can resume at a future time if the need recurs.

Skirball Hospice does not exclude, deny benefits to, or otherwise discriminate against any person on the grounds of race, color, ancestry, national origin, mental or physical handicap, sex, sexual orientation or religion. This is true for both services provided directly by Skirball Hospice as well as through a contractor. While there is no discrimination due to age at admission, our services are provided for persons over the age of 18 as care of infants, children and young adults at the end of life is provided by organizations with specific training and capability.

Skirball Hospice is a program of the non-profit Los Angeles Jewish Home and is funded in part by the Skirball Foundation but has no beneficial relationships with any other referring entities.

- Physician visit within 7–14 days of hospice admission
- Pain control and symptom management

- Emotional and spiritual support
- On-call availability nights and weekends
- Volunteer support and companionship opportunities
- Bereavement services for 13 months following hospice care

Information for Physicians

Admission to hospice is voluntary and begins with an order faxed or phoned to our office. You may continue as the primary care physician, unless you indicate otherwise. Consultations are available from our hospice Medical Director, who is an Assistant Clinical Professor at UCLA and board certified in Hospice and Palliative Medicine and Internal Medicine. Please consider referring when your patient has had a decline in condition and hospitalization interventions are no longer beneficial. Hospice diagnoses may include but are not limited to:
